Aftercare after Fusion Plasma Treatment:

Complications that may occur after the thermal procedure

In both procedures, itching, redness, crusting, odema, swelling, can be seen in the application area. Especially since the eye area and eyelid are sensitive, possible odema and swelling will go away on their own within 1-5 days. If hygiene rules are not observed, infection may occur in the application area. The crusting that occurs in the application area of the person who has the procedure, or the product that is not recommended by the expert, etc. If it is interfered with, staining may occur.

Aftercare

After the procedure, the treated area should be protected from the sun.

The treated area should not come into contact with water for the first 24 hours after the procedure.

After the procedure, the treated area should be cleaned and protected within the framework of hygiene rules.

The crusting that occurs in the treatment area after the should never be picked off by hand or by any product.

The crusting should be expected to shed on it's own.

Cosmetic product should not be applied to the treated area for the first 24 hours after the procedure.

The first 2 days after the treatment, pool, sea, sports, solarium, sauna, etc. and aerobics should be avoided.
